Short stay intermediate

care can help people to regain their confidence and independence after a hospital stay and before they return home. It also offers temporary care and support for people if they need to be away from their own home for another reason, e.g. if adaptations to their home are taking place.

‘Step up, step down’ facilities are now available throughout Torfaen, offering support to people who need support to regain their independence.

Several units are available within sheltered housing complexes for people over 60, while younger adults will live temporarily in one of two adapted houses which are ex-warden accommodation.



Short stay intermediate care is intended to be just that – with people staying in the units from four days up to six weeks depending on their circumstances and how quickly they regain independent living skills.

All housing units have been adapted so that care and support can be provided readily and any appropriate telecare monitors and detectors can be put in place.

Working in partnership

All housing units are provided by Bron Afon Community Housing and are rented to the Council. It is the Council and not the individual who is the tenant.

Individual support packages are co-ordinated by Torfaen Intermediate Care Team (funded jointly by the Council and the Local Health Board). Care is provided by the British Red Cross (if the person does not have carers already).

Will people be charged for the service?

Rent, service charges and utility bills are paid by the Council and LHB. There is no cost to the individual for the care and support that is provided. **However**



individuals need to sign a short stay licence agreement, and may be charged if stays extend beyond the planned reablement period. Units are fully furnished.

Individuals are responsible, however, for buying their own food and paying for telephone calls. People also need to bring their own towels, bed linen and personal items.

How to make a referral

All referrals are made by professionals in agreement with the service user and their carer(s). In practice, this means that a multi-disciplinary team, including nurses, social workers, doctors and other health professionals will assess whether someone is medically fit to leave hospital, and if so, **to link with intermediate care team to determine what type of support needs to be put in place for them to do so, and the detail of a reablement package.**

If short stay intermediate care is suitable, a referral will be made to the Intermediate Care Team, which will provide a key worker to co-ordinate the move and the care package, which will need to be arranged in **conjunction with referrer.**
