**NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO REVIEW THE PREMISES

51 LICENSING ACT 2003**

An application to review the premises licence of the Kingfisher, under section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003 has been submitted to Torfaen County Borough Council, Licensing Authority.

The licence currently authorises the sale of alcohol and the provision of regulated entertainment on the premises as prescribed by The Licensing Act 2003.

The grounds for the application are that the premises breach one of the licensing objectives prescribed by the Licensing Act 2003 in particular "The Prevention of Crime and Disorder, The Prevention Of Public Nuisance and Public Safety".

There now follows a 28 day consultation period which concludes on Tuesday 1st January 2008 within which time representations on the above licensing objective will be accepted in writing to the Licensing Authority on the below postal or e-mail address.
