In accordance with the duties under sections 7 (3) and 10 (2) of the Active Travel (Wales) Act 2013, please find below Torfaen County Borough Council's annual report for 2017-2018.

The actions taken to promote active travel journeys

LTF funding in 2017-2018 was awarded to construct phase 1 of the Triangle Active Travel route. The scheme delivered improvements to the main sustainable walking route between New Inn and Pontypool. This is the direct route between the Council's two main premises and these buildings house a large number of staff. Completed July 2018.

In the 2017-2018 financial year we also received SRiC awards for safe walking routes and road safety improvements for 3 schemes, Trosnant street & Ysgol Panteg in Pontypool and phase Cwmffrwdoer, Pentrepiod & Pentwyn. These works saw improvements to walking routes in and around the surrounding areas and improvements to junction safety on cycle route NCN492 in Griffithstown.

Bids were submitted to the WG for funding from both LTF and SRiC for 2018-2019.

Continued to deliver National Standards cycle training and the traditional cycling proficiency training in 2017-18 which provided young cyclists with the necessary training to be safer and more competent cyclists.

Kerbcraft training was delivered to 1000+ school pupils throughout 2017-18 to give young pupils the skills and road safety awareness to be safer pedestrians.
