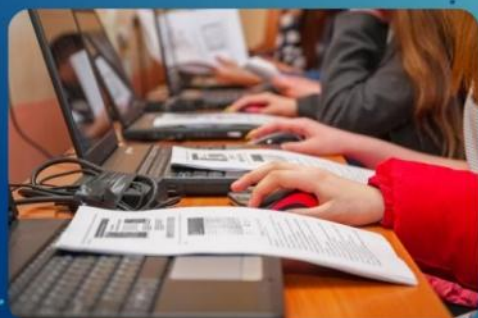

HOW TO ENROL

Paying for your course

You can pay with a credit or debit card over the phone or in person at any of our centres.

Where there is a fee and to guarantee a place on your chosen course, you will need to pay a minimum of 50% of the tuition fee (**non refundable or transferable**). The remaining balance can be paid at any time before the commencement of the course, but no later than 4 weeks after the start date. All course places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

NOTE: Courses that are 8 weeks or less must be paid in full to secure a place.

Torfaen Adult Community Learning reserves the right to cancel and change courses.

In such cases, a full or proportionate refund may be given. Classes that do not reach the required number of learners will not start.

Once enrolled on a course, learners are liable for all costs.

No refunds are given unless the course is cancelled.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS FOR EMPLOYMENT

GCSE - WJEC

Our highly successful GCSE Maths and English courses are the gateway to a brighter future. They could be your passport to employment, new career goals or entry into higher education. These intensive courses require regular attendance and extra work at home. The WJEC set syllabus is followed. Scheduled examinations take place in May and June 2027.

GCSE English - You will need to be a good reader, be confident about writing, be able to express your ideas and respond in a discussion. You will follow the WJEC set syllabus which will include reading and critically evaluating texts, summarising and synthesising information and ideas, and effectively using standard English, grammar, punctuation and spelling in writing.

GCSE Maths - You will need to have a good basic understanding of mathematical principles. You will follow the WJEC set syllabus. Topics include number, data handling, algebra and shape.

NEW Essential Skills Wales Qualifications

Level 2, Essential Skills Wales Communication and Numeracy qualifications can help you develop essential skills for personal growth and career development. Learners can gain a solid foundation in key skills such as communication, numeracy and digital skills. These qualifications are often a prerequisite for further education, apprenticeships and other career opportunities.

Counselling Skills Level 2 and Level 3 - AIM

The AIM suite of counselling qualifications is available for learners at different stages of their careers in counselling. They are designed, taking into account professional counselling bodies' requirements for the accreditation of counsellors and is structured to ensure their requirements in terms of guided learning hours and practicum are covered.

AIM Qualifications Level 2 Counselling Skills - Learners are introduced to the roots of counselling theory and how theory underpins counselling skills. This qualification provides a rudimentary understanding of the three main areas of counselling theory and how they can relate to counselling practice. Learners will also begin to develop their practical skills in developing, maintaining and concluding a basic counselling session, providing them with the skills, knowledge and understanding of practice within the boundaries of an ethical framework.

This qualification has been designed as a step in the ladder for professional development for aspiring and practising counsellors. Learners may progress onto the AIM Qualifications Level 3 Certificate in Counselling.

AIM Qualifications Level 3 Certificate in Counselling - This qualification enables learners to work towards becoming a reflective practitioner of counselling by considering theories of human development, self-awareness, supervision and issues of difference and diversity. It also provides knowledge and understanding of the main core theories and theorists that underpin counselling and addresses the nature of psychological problems and how they may be approached.

The specialist skills and knowledge gained in this qualification will be applicable in a range of working contexts. It will enable learners to understand the need for a firm grasp of a coherent theoretical approach to counselling or supporting others. This is particularly important prior to starting work in a supervised placement if learners progress to Level 4.

NEW Working with Children and Young Adults

If you are looking for a pathway to a qualification or considering working with Children or Young Adults we have the course for you.

Award in Understanding Mental Wellbeing Level 2 - RSPH

The objective of this qualification is to provide candidates with a knowledge and understanding of the principles of mental wellbeing, the effect of mental wellbeing on the individual and community, and how mental wellbeing can be maintained or improved.

The qualification will provide learners with an understanding of the importance of mental wellbeing, the theoretical models that can be used to describe it and factors that may affect it.

Award in Asbestos Awareness Level 1 - Highfield

This qualification is designed for those who may be exposed to asbestos within their working environment and require a simple overview of the risks.

Holders of this qualification will be able to explain the effects of asbestos on the health of individuals, the types of material likely to contain asbestos, the location of these materials within buildings, and procedures for minimising the risk of asbestos fibre release.

Award in the Principles of Fire Safety Awareness Level 1 - Highfield

This qualification is aimed at all staff, particularly new starters in any workplace, where a basic understanding of fire safety is required. Topics include:

- Principles of fire safety awareness
- Hazards and risk with fire in the workplace
- Controlling fire risks

Food Safety for Catering Level 2 - Highfield

The objective of this qualification is to prepare learners for employment in a catering role, or to support a role in the workplace. Topics include:

- Importance of food handlers keeping themselves clean and hygienic
- Keeping work areas clean and hygienic
- Importance of keeping food products safe
- Principles of food safety

Emergency Paediatric First Aid Level 3 - QA

This regulated and nationally recognised qualification provides learners with the opportunity to develop the basic skills and knowledge needed to deal with a range of emergency paediatric first aid situations which could arise when looking after children.

Intended Audience:

- Those who have gained a level 2 or 3 childcare qualification and have entered into an early years setting and wish to be included in the staff to child ratios to comply with the EYFS requirements.
- Anyone who cares for infants and children, such as parents, guardians, grandparents or those who have an involvement with infants and children, and wants to learn key paediatric first aid skills.

Award in First Aid Essentials Level 2 - QA

This regulated and nationally recognised qualification enables learners to gain the skills and knowledge needed to administer safe, prompt, effective first aid in situations which can arise when providing care. During this one day course, learners will develop the skills and knowledge needed to deal with a range of first aid situations, including: managing an unresponsive casualty, CPR, choking, external bleeding, shock and minor injuries.

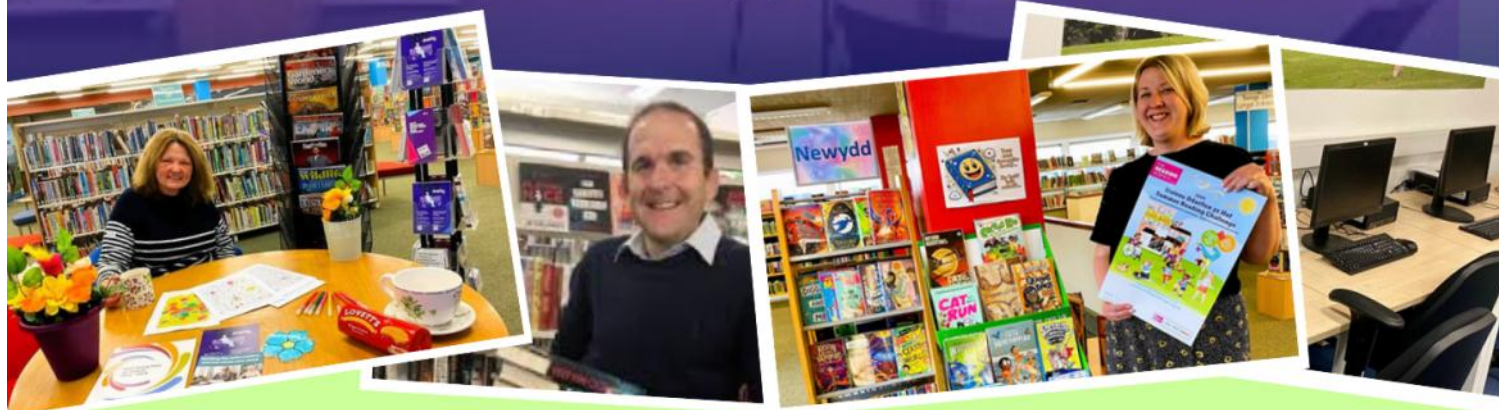
