Background

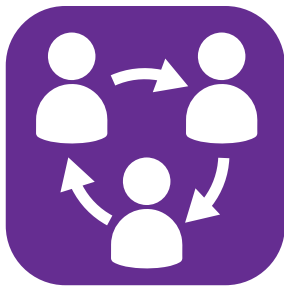

All our engagement is guided by legislative requirements and nationally recognised standards and principles. More information about these can be found by clicking on the images below.



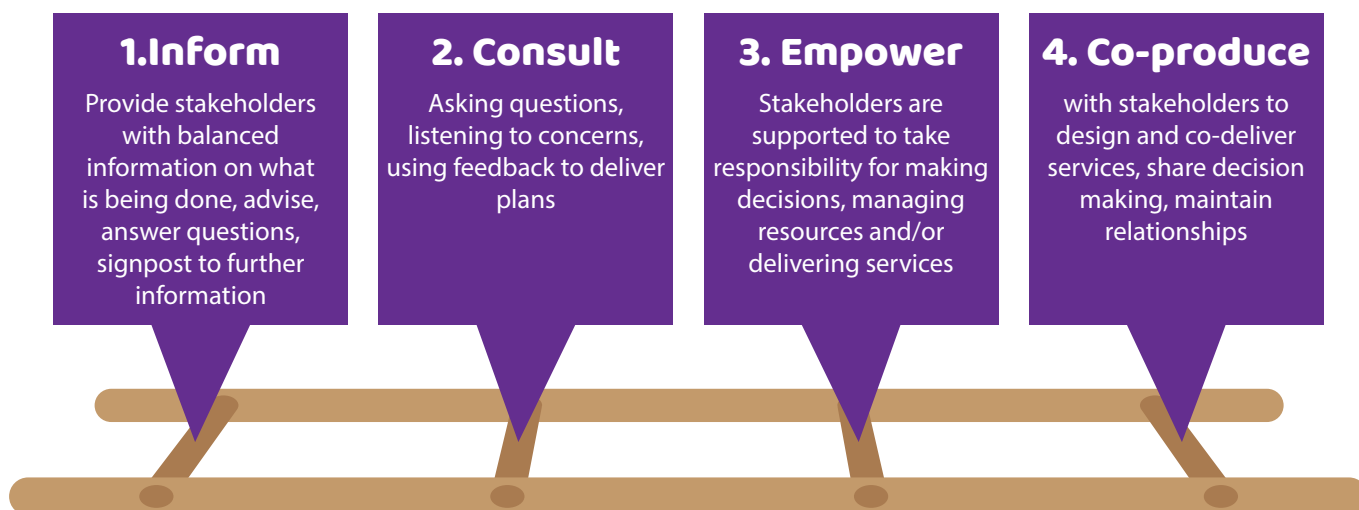
For us participation means:
