### **Notice of Adoption of a Local Development Plan**

Torfaen Local Development Plan (to 2021)

On 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2013, Torfaen County Borough Council adopted a Local Development Plan (LDP) for Torfaen (excluding the area within the Brecon Beacons National Park). The adopted LDP will form the development plan for Torfaen (excluding the area within the Brecon Beacons National Park) and will be the basis for decisions on land use planning in this area.

Copies of the adopted LDP, the recommendations of the person appointed to hold the independent examination, the sustainability appraisal report (incorporating the environmental report), the consultation report and a statement indicating how the environmental report etc. has been taken into account are available for inspection free of charge, during normal office / opening days and hours at:

- Planning & Public Protection Offices, Ty Blaen Torfaen, New Inn;
- Main Reception, Civic Centre Pontypool; and
- All public and mobile libraries in Torfaen.

Copies of the LDP, including its proposal map, will be available for purchase from the Ty Blaen Torfaen Offices (address below) after 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2014.

The LDP became operative on its adoption, i.e. 3<sup>rd</sup> December 2013.

A person aggrieved by the LDP who desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by Part 6 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 or that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the LDP, may, within six weeks from 11<sup>th</sup> December 2013, make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the 2004 Act.
