Control of 1. demonstrations of hypnotism at other places	No person shall give an exhibition, demonstration or performance of hypnotism on any living person at or in connection with an entertainment to which the public are admitted, whether on payment or otherwise, at any place in relation to which such a licence as is mentioned in section one of this Act is not in force unless the controlling authority have

## Prohibition of hypnotising persons under twenty-one

3. A person who gives an exhibition, demonstration, or performance of hypnotism on a person who has not attained the age of twenty-one years at or in connection with an entertainment to which the public are admitted, whether on payment or otherwise, shall, unless he had reasonable cause to believe that the persons had attained that age, be liable on summary conviction to fine not exceeding fifty pounds.

## Entry of premises

4. Any police constable may enter any premises where any entertainment is held if he has reasonable cause to believe that any act is being or may be done in contravention of this Act.

## Hypnotism

5. Hypnotism is defined in the Act as including hypnotism, mesmerism and any similar act or process which produces, or is intended to produce in any person any form of induced sleep or trance in which the susceptibility of the mind of that person to suggestion or direction is increased or intended to be increased but does not include hypnotism, mesmerism or any such similar act or process which is self-induced.
