As a leading provider of community learning in the borough, we ensure that our courses are of the highest quality.

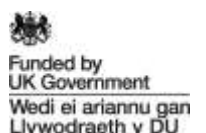

HOW TO ENROL

By phone or in person

You can enrol on a course by telephoning 01633 647647 or by visiting one of our centres where our team will be happy to provide you with further information and assist you to enrol.

During term time, our opening hours are Monday to Thursday 8.30am to 9.15pm and Friday 8.30am to 4.00pm. During school holidays, our opening times are Monday to Thursday 8.30am to 4.30pm and Friday 8.30am to 4.00pm.

Paying for your course

You can pay with a credit or debit card over the phone or in person at any of our centres.

Where there is a fee and to guarantee a place on your chosen course, you will need to pay a minimum of 50% of the tuition fee (**non refundable**). The remaining balance can be paid at any time before the commencement of the course, but no later than 4 weeks after the start date. All course places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

NOTE: Courses that are 8 weeks or less must be paid in full to secure a place.

Torfaen Adult Community Learning reserves the right to cancel and change courses.

In such cases, a full or proportionate refund may be given. Classes that do not reach the required number of learners will not start.

Once enrolled on a course, learners are liable for all costs.

No refunds are given unless the course is cancelled.

GCSE - WJEC

Our highly successful GCSE Maths and English courses are the gateway to a brighter future. They could be your passport to employment, new career goals or entry into higher education. These intensive courses require regular attendance and extra work at home. They follow the WJEC set syllabus and topics. Scheduled examinations take place in May and June 2025.

GCSE English

You will need to be a good reader, be confident about writing, be able to express your ideas and respond in a discussion. You will follow the WJEC set syllabus which will include reading and critically evaluating texts, summarising and synthesising information and ideas, and effectively using standard English, grammar, punctuation and spelling in writing.

GCSE Maths

You will need to have a good basic understanding of mathematical principles. You will follow the WJEC set syllabus and topics including number, data handling, algebra and shape.

Counselling Skills Level 2 and Level 3 - AIM

Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools Level 2 - City and Guilds

Our Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools courses are for those wishing to gain the skills necessary to work as a Teaching Assistant in schools. These intensive courses require regular attendance and extra work at home. They follow the City and Guilds syllabus and topics, and are assessed via a portfolio of assignments.

This course includes support with digital skills and numeracy skills.

Level 2 Award in First Aid Essentials - QA

As part of the course, you will be expected to gain practical experience in a school or college, for at least one day per week, as an employee or volunteer – so it's important you arrange your placement before enrolling.

NCFE CACHE Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning in Schools Level 3

This course is for:

- anyone in a support role at a school or college as a classroom assistant or learning and support assistant, or in a voluntary support role.

Entry Requirements

RSPH Level 1 Award in Health and Safety in a Construction Environment

This qualification is suitable for everyone (or anyone) seeking employment in labouring occupations in the construction industry, who is looking to obtain their Labourer's Green Card.

Successful achievement of this Level 1 qualification will demonstrate an individual's knowledge and understanding of the health and safety requirements of a construction site.

Option 1: Complete self-directed learning modules online, where you will also be able to access practice assessments through the portal. Once completed you can then book your multiple-choice test at one of our local test centres.

Option 2: One-day centre-based training with a qualified tutor, where you will complete learning modules and a final multiple-choice test at one of our local test centres. *

*This option will involve pre-learning to meet awarding body requirements.

Once you have completed this qualification you are also required to complete the CITB HS&E test to gain your full Construction Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) Labourers' Green Card.
